

From the small to the ridiculous

Flower Power garden products now produce plant supports of all sizes: ranging from the small, single stem plant supports, called 'Plant Crooks'; to the gigantic 'Bower Belles', big enough to sit under.

Launching at the Four Oaks Trade show in September, the Plant Belle family is still growing. On stand OP31 you will find the original Plant Belles for the border, Belles for plant pots, and now Belles for yourself.

The Bower Belle is an outside room, offering shelter for people and support for plants. The majestic Belle structure is 3.5m high, when covered with climbing plants it creates a green room in the garden. The Bower Belle offers shade and enclosure for dining, or 'hiding-out' to watch the wildlife. The smaller Bower Belle makes a great den for the younger members of the family.

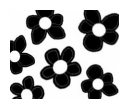
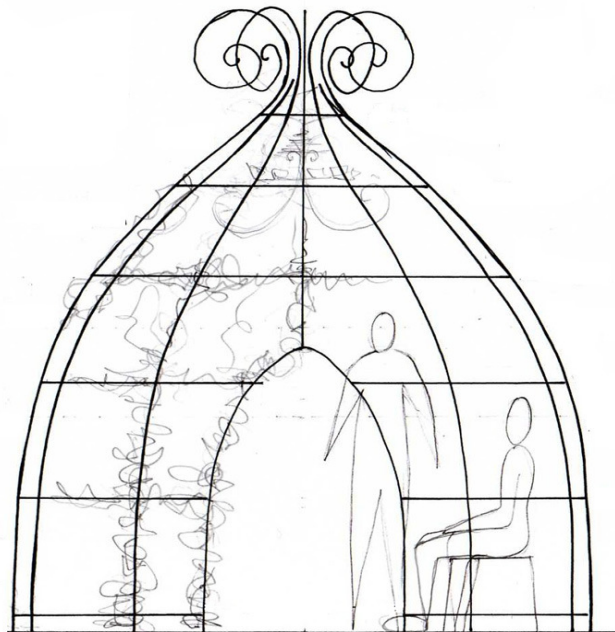
The Belle Tower is nearly 2m tall, originally designed for tomato plants and sweet peas, but is also suitable for all sorts of climbing plants.

The Plant Belle range is further supported with the invention of the Plant Crook. A clever new single stem plant support, designed to be used with the Plant Belles, in the height of the flowering season. The Crooks offer extra support for tall, heavy or delicate flower stems, an ideal solution for heady Delphiniums. Available in two sizes 85cm and 105cm high, they work just as well independently as stem supports around the garden.

Plant Belles

The border range



Christopher stands 40cm tall by 40cm wide. This Belle has an open design, good for broad and rosette leaf forms. A good choice for perennials that have a tendency to fall open from the middle; Yarrow, unruly Nepeta, Shasta and Michaelmas daisy, Monarda, even Sedums benefit from the open support.



Margery stands 50cm tall by 40cm wide. Good at the front of the border, for smaller plants of all shapes and sizes, for example Penstemon, Echinacea and Geraniums.

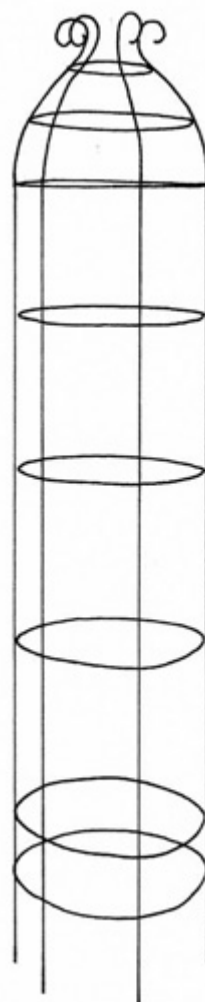


Gertrude stands 45cm tall by 50cm wide. Works well with strappy leaved plants. Wide enough to support a group of three perennials. Great also for Siberian Iris, Asters, Veronica and Poppies.



Ernest stands 60cm tall by 42cm wide. The tallest of the group, he offers great support for tall Montbretias, Delphiniums, Thalictrum, Scabious and Evening primrose.

Belle Tower
180cm tall by 37cm wide.
Designed originally for sweet peas, the tower will support all sorts of climbing plants.
